HELPFUL HINTS FOR SENIORS:

- Scholarship Lists updated bi-weekly and can also be found on the Counseling webpage at sbps.net. Hard copies are in the Counseling Office on the wall; a different color indicates a new list. Hint: you can see them from the hallway! G

- Transcript requests for scholarship (please do not wait until the last minute) or admission applications can be made in our office <u>by the student</u>. Know your deadlines, plan ahead, use reminder apps.
- As a courtesy, ask for letters of recommendation in advance, i.e.teachers, counselors, administrators, employers do not wait until the last minute to ask someone you value to write one on your behalf.
- Keep track of your logins and passwords for online scholarship accounts, and even admissions/school accounts.
- Know your application for admission deadlines to various schools. Every school is different. Pay attention to their general scholarship application deadlines too!
- Sign up for newsletters of outside, national scholarship offerings. Be wary of third party sites. Use our recommended sites listed by our office if you're not sure.
- Take advantage of EdQuest meetings, parent meetings and FAFSA assistance this Fall and Winter. Pay attention to REMIND or social media advertising these events.
- Organization is key!
